The Protection- Πокрова of the Mother of God

The Feast of the Protection commemorates the appearance of the most holy Theotokos in the Church of Blachernae in Constantinople in the early sixth century, as recorded in the life of Saint Andrew the Fool for Christ's sake. While the multitudes of the faithful were gathered in church, Epiphanius, the friend of Saint Andrew, through the Saint's prayers, beheld the Virgin Mary above the faithful and spreading out her veil over them, signifying her unceasing protection of all Christians. Because of this we keep a yearly feast of gratitude, imploring our Lady never to cease sheltering us in her mighty prayers.

This is the origin of the Feast of the Protection. But this feast goes beyond mere history. This is the feast of the Theotokos as she lives today, for us, with us. We know this because it is the essential content of our prayers to her: "O unfailing patroness of Christians, O steadfast advocate before the Creator, turn not away from us sinners as we call out to you in prayer, but rather as our gracious Lady, come to our aid as we trustingly appeal to you. Quickly hear our prayer and make it your own speedy plea, for you always intercede in behalf of those who honor you, O Mother of God!"
